How To Use the Interactive Map:

- 1 - Make sure that your browser is up to date. If you face technical problems, try using a different browser.
- 2 - Adjust the interactive map to your screen by using your browser's zoom.
- 3 - Choose the language you want to study.
- 4 - On the world map, choose an area where the target language is spoken. You can zoom in and out by using the "+" and "-" buttons, at the top left.
- 5 - Choose an icon and click on it. You will hear a question. You can replay the questions as many times as necessary. If you don't understand the question, you can read it by clicking on the "question mark" button.
- 6 - Answer the question using the "drag and drop" function: place the words on the line in order to get a full sentence. Check your answer by clicking on the "check" button.
- 7 - There might be a second or a third question: click on the double arrow above the "check" button.
- 8 - You can also access to the interactive map of some capital cities (Beijing, Berlin, Madrid, Paris and Tokyo) by clicking on the red label indicating their names.
- 9 - To return to the world map, click on the arrow at the bottom right.
- 10 - You can thereafter talk about your native country, using the same type of questions and answers. You may find new topics by looking at the different maps.
